EVERYONE: Please **DO NOT LABEL** these with your child's name

- 1 - 1 inch 3 ring binder - one color with clear plastic slot on the front cover (new to E2 students only)
- 4 solid colored composition notebooks (college ruled) (1red, 1blue, 1yellow, 1green)
- 1 spiral bound on left side graph paper notebook (size should be 4x4 squares per inch)
- 1 transparent plastic ruler (with inches and centimeters)
- 2 boxes of BIC mechanical pencils (please do not substitute for a different brand)
- 2 solid colored plastic folders
- 2 Clorox/Lysol Wipes
- 4 white glue sticks
- 1 pack 3x3 Post-it notes
- 1 pack 1.5x2 Post-it notes
- package of dry-erase markers (thick tip is best)
- 3x5 note cards (white)
- loose leaf 4x4 graph paper
- loose leaf college ruled paper

EVERYONE: Please label with your child's name
